

Prior to July 2014 the Lake Illawarra Authority (LIA) jointly managed the Lake Illawarra foreshore public lands with Wollongong City Council and Shellharbour City Council.

At this time all LIA was disbanded and land and assets were transferred back to the State Government and local Councils. This brochure provides information on which public lands and assets each Agency is responsible for.

The remainder of the lake foreshore is privately owned and managed.

Department of Primary Industries - Lands is responsible for:

- Berkeley Harbour and Kiosk, Yallah Bay open space, old squash court, jetties, and paths
- The shared path and boardwalk from Gilba Rd to Yallah Bay
- The units on Judbooley Pde and the foreshore strip from Judbooley Reserve to the west
- Works and infrastructure around the Lake entrance
- All private foreshore structures on the Lake except those in Kully Bay
- All public jetties, wharves and boat ramps on the Lake in the Wollongong LGA

- Northcliffe Dr open space from Naval Cadets in the west to King St in the east
- Jetties and wharves adjacent to these lands

- Fred Finch Park
- Lakeside Ave
- Kanahooka
- Purry Burry Ave
- Primbee
- Judbooley Pde (east from the units on Judbooley Pde)
- The foreshore and boardwalk adjacent to Windang Beach Tourist Park
- Stormwater outlets within the Wollongong LGA

- Foreshore lands around Karoo Bay and Koona Bay
- Stormwater outlets within the Shellharbour LGA
- Public foreshore structures in the Lake in the Shellharbour LGA

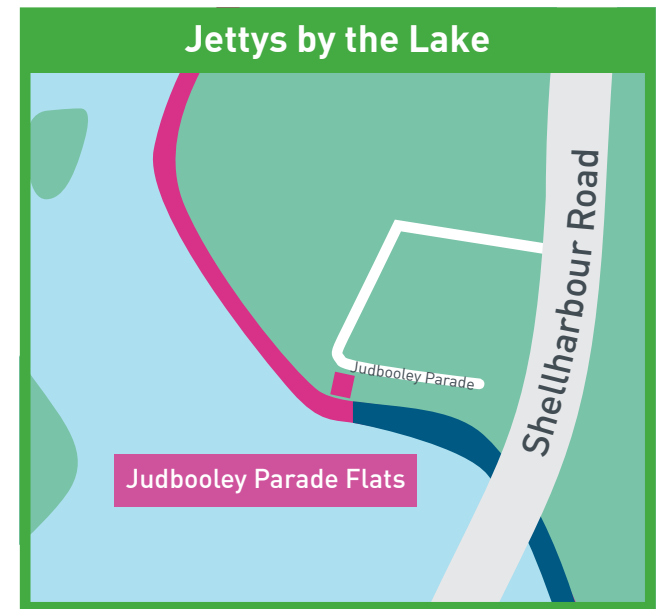
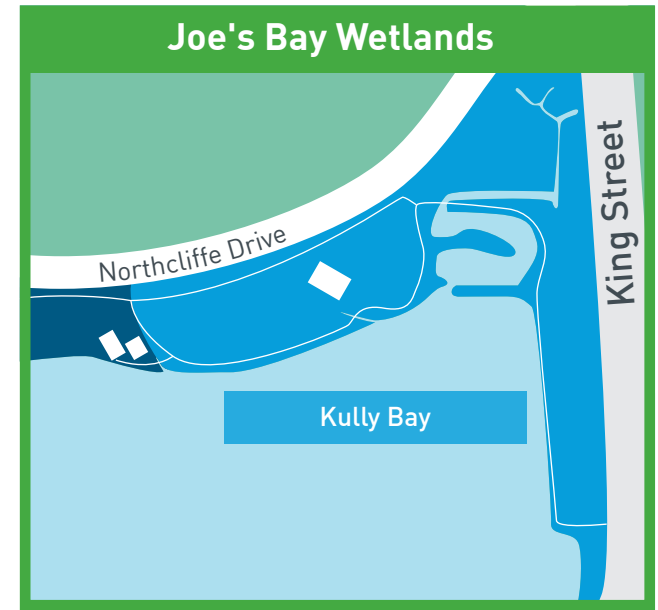
