Harry Graham Drive

Road stabilisation work on Harry Graham Drive is due to commence on Monday 22 June with Council now finalizing the contract of works with local company Glennos Constructions Pty Ltd.

Wollongong City Council is committed to reopening Harry Graham Drive and approved a new \$1.6 million tender with Glennos Constructions Pty Ltd at the May Council meeting.

The proposed road stabilisation works will involve the construction of a deep subsurface drainage line, 10m deep reinforced concrete piles to form the slope retaining structure and the reconstruction of the road. This work will take approximately four months.

Following the completion of the contract works, Council will then be able to finalise the cliff stabilisation works which will involve rock bolting, installation of galvanized meshing and grouting. You may recall the cliff stabilisation works had to be suspended due to the unsafe conditions of the area at that time.

The construction works will require the complete closure of the affected area of Harry Graham Drive as it will be a designated worksite. However, residents and motorists will have an alternative access along Cordeaux Road or Mt Keira Road.

Although a final completion date cannot be determined until after the cliff stabilisation works have commenced, Wollongong City Council is committed to keeping the community informed on the progress of works.
