#### **Crown Lands Presentation**

Helen Wheeler addressed the meeting to determine interest in the community forming a board to manage the crown land reserve, which includes the old railway tunnel at the entrance to Helensburgh railway station, as the Department of Lands does not have the resources to maintain the reserve. Fences and lockable gates have been installed across the entrance to both tunnels due to concerns arising from vandalism to the old railway tunnel, platform and sign.
