PANEL CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

The Panel considered the matters listed at item 7, and the material presented at the meeting and the matters observed at site inspections listed at item 8 in Schedule 1.

The Panel determined to approve the development application as described in Schedule 1 pursuant to section 4.16 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The decision was unanimous.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The reasons for the decision of the Panel were:

- The Panel accepted the recommendation of staff to approve the temporary use of the site for Major Events up to a maximum of 52 days in any 12-month period. The Panel acknowledges that the 52 days includes the 'bump in' and 'bump out' days related to each unique event.
- However, the Panel would like to ensure that the cricket oval is protected as much as is reasonable and would therefore add a further condition to control the use of that space within the entire application site

CONDITIONS

The development application was approved subject to the conditions in the Council Assessment Report with the following amendments.

Add Condition 3 as a new 3(d)

'Any activities in or on the King George V cricket oval are to be those activities which have minimum compaction and/or disturbance of the ground surface'
