Tallawarra B is designed to operate with a 5 per cent volume of green hydrogen from 2025 and a modification application is underway to seek approval for this change.

# Items needing urgent attention:

- 1. West Dapto Road major reconstruction of first 600 meters from the railway line to Kembla Grange Car Storage Facility due to the extremely dangerous flood prone nature of this section and NO LIGHTING provided by WCC!!
- 2. Avondale Road from the Princes Highway to the railway line has scores of potholes of various sizes which need urgent attention
- 3. Lucas Drive from Bovard Court to Fairwater Drive has several potholes already opening up with little rain in the last month!! Needs major upgrade to high density bitumen as is major arterial connection!
- 4. Cleveland Road West is the secondary entry point for the future 500 lots of the new subdivision at Stocklands Forest Ridge Estate-Why is our councillors, WCC and the Joint Regional Planning Panel allowing the approval of this major subdivision with one of the two entry points being a very flood prone, extremely dangerous goat track with NO LIGHTING known as Cleveland Road West???
