#### 2 FLOOD MANAGEMENT UPDATE

#### 2.1 Duck Creek Flood Study

The engagement sessions for this study indicated support from the community for this area. The <u>Report</u> was adopted by Council on 24 June 2019. The document will available from Council's new website on 8 August 2019

#### 2.2 Mullet Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan

The consultant from Rhelm provided a brief presentation and advised that the draft study was at the model calibration stage.

#### 2.3 Minnegang Creek Flood Study Review

#### 2.5 Implementation Flood Mitigation Options

Council's Floodplain and Stormwater Unit Leader advised that the Barina Park Detention Basin is classified as a "Prescribed Basin" and discussed with the committee a proposed long term plan to manage risks in this area.

#### 3 GENERAL BUSINESS

During the Minnegang Creek Flood Study presentation, the SES representative advised that they may have data relating to flood rescues for the Northcliffe Drive area. Council requested this data be provided.

Additionally, Community members questioned the ownership of a Flood Alert Box at the bottom of Mount Ousley Road off the Princes Highway and the recently installed structures at Warrawong Shopping Centre. Council is to investigate the ownership of these structures and report back at the next meeting.

A Committee member raised concerns about shipping containers located downstream of Anama Street which in time of floods could be mobilised and block downstream culverts on Memorial Drive causing further flooding.

Council's Manager Infrastructure Strategy & Planning responded to concerns regarding the geographic position of Wollongong SES Unit in Montague Street as floods affect access in this area and he confirmed that Council had been working with the SES regarding relocation.
