How I become a member of the library


When I get to the library I will see a desk.



I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library.



I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address.



I will need to bring two forms of identification.


This can be a driving licence, bank statement, rental receipt or household bill.

One of them will need to show my name and address such as a concession card.



I will be asked a few questions and given some information about what I can borrow.

I will receive a library card. This makes me a member of the library.



When I visit the library

When I arrive at the library, I will need to sanitise my hands.



I will also need to register my visit by using the QR code.

WE'RE COVID SAFE

Please check in before entering our premises.

We're helping keep our community COVID safe by recording contact details.

It's easy to check in:

- 1 Scan the QR code with your smartphone camera or QR code reader.
- 2 Follow the prompts on the Service NSW app or on the Service NSW webform.
- 3 Show a staff member that you've signed in.


If I cannot register myself, I can talk to the library staff who will ask me some questions and do it for me.



In the library there will be arrows on the floor directing me to the shelves of books, CDs, DVDs and magazines.



I can borrow a book, CD, DVD or magazine and take it home with me for four weeks.




If I want to borrow a book, CD, DVD or magazine I will talk to a member of the library staff.



The staff will show me how to borrow the book, CD, DVD or magazine and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.



The library will have limited computers available for use.



The library has some sensory tools I can borrow when I am in the library. I can ask a librarian to borrow sensory tools.



When I have finished, I will leave the library.


I'll come back to my library to return the things I borrowed. I will find new things to take home!
