We're working on Floodplain Risk Management Studies and Plans for both the Allans Creek catchment (Mount Keira, West Wollongong, Figtree, Mount Kembla, Unanderra, Farmborough Heights and Berkeley) and Fairy & Cabbage Tree Creeks catchment (between Towradgi and the southern end of Wollongong).

We're planning ways to manage the risks from floods and are asking the community to be involved in this planning.
