



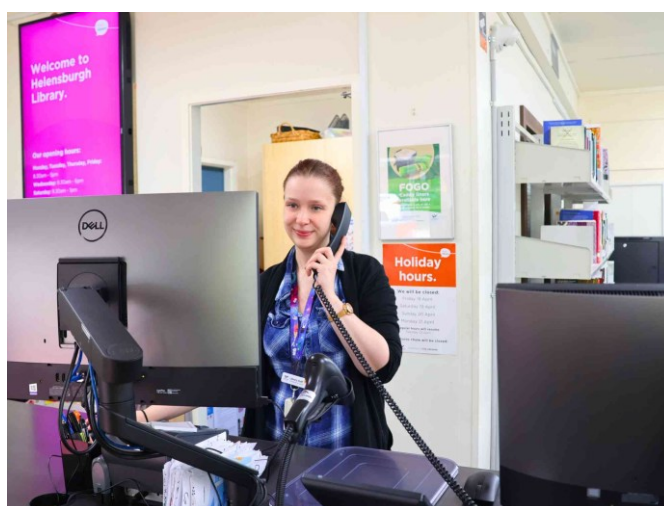
Going to Helensburgh Library

About the library

There are people who work at the library who I can talk to.



The library is usually a quiet place where people talk quietly, relax and read books.

How I become a member of the library

I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number, and email address.



I will need to bring one form of identification with my name and address, such as a driver's licence or concession card.



I'll answer some questions and learn about borrowing. I will receive a library card, and this makes me a library member.



When I visit the library

In the library there will be shelves of books, CDs, DVDs, and magazines.



I can sit in a chair to read a book.



I can borrow a book, CD, DVD, or magazine and take it home with me for four weeks.



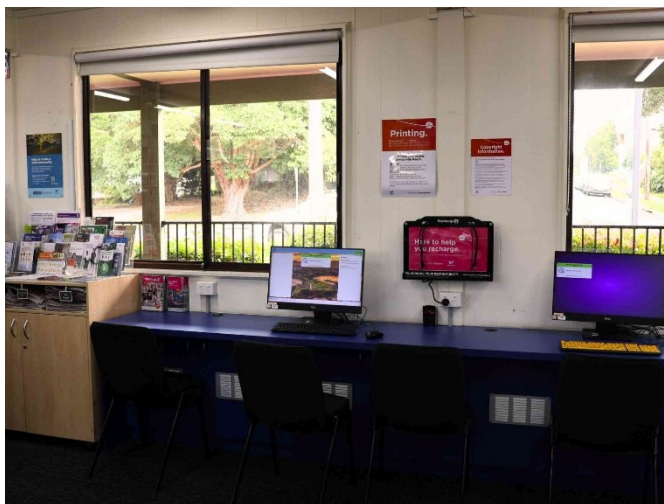
If I want to borrow a book, CD, DVD, or magazine I will talk to a library staff member.



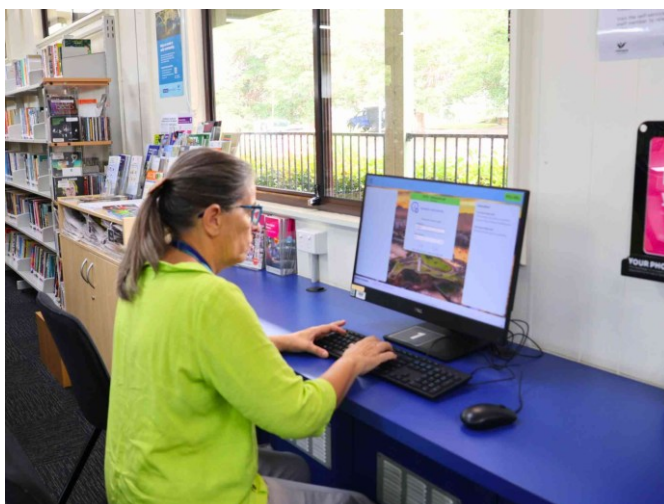
The staff will show me how to borrow the book, CD, DVD, or magazine and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library.



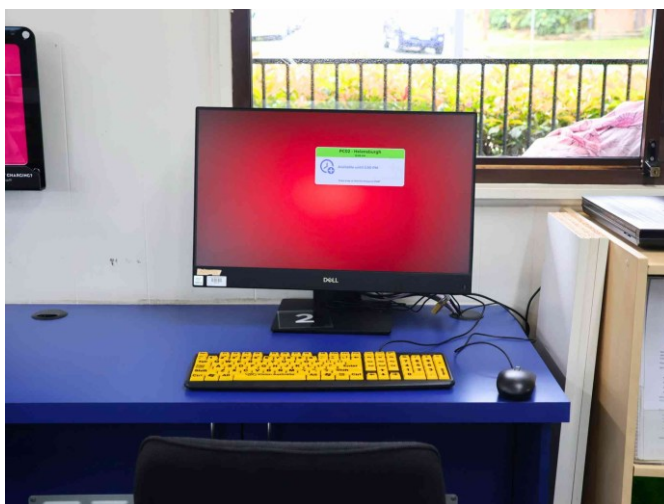
The library will also have some computers.

One of the computers has a Vision Australia keyboard for people with low vision.



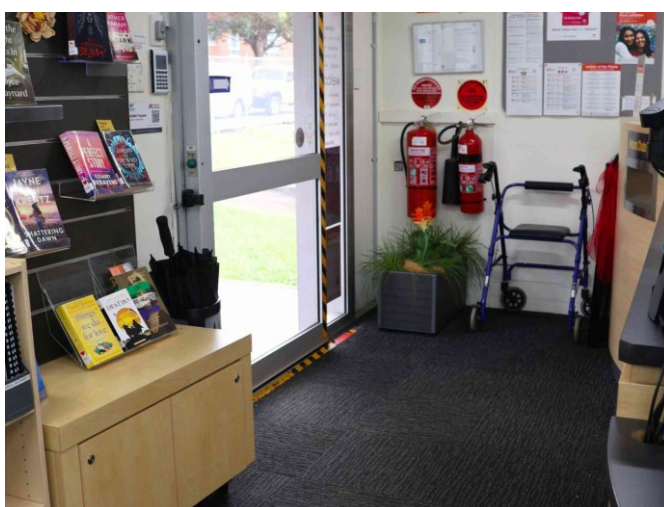
The library has some sensory tools I can borrow when I am in the library. I can ask a library staff member to borrow sensory tools.

I will leave the library through the main door.



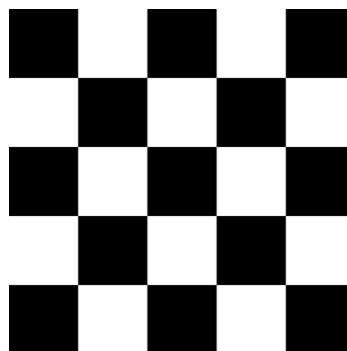
I'll come back to my library to return the things I borrowed and find new things to take home!
