#### 2 FLOOD MANAGEMENT UPDATE

#### 2.1 Collins Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan Review

Council is progressing the review of the Collins Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan. This project is funded by Council and seeks to identify the flood risks and damages to this catchment and assess and prioritise floodplain risk mitigation options.

The consultant is currently progressing data collection and review.

#### 2.2 Hewitts Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan Review

Council has progressed the review of the Hewitts Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan. This project is funded by the NSW Flood Program and Council and seeks to identify the flood risks and damages to this catchment and assess and prioritise floodplain risk mitigation options.

Consultant has completed:

- Data collection and review
- Flood damages and floodplain risk management options assessment
- Draft Floodplain Risk Management Study report

An update will be provided by Council's consultant.

#### 2.3 Towradgi Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan Review

Council has progressed the review of the Towradgi Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan. This project is funded by the NSW Flood Program and Council, and seeks to identify the flood risks and damages to this catchment and assess and prioritise floodplain risk mitigation options.

Consultant has completed:



- Data collection and review
- Flood damages and floodplain risk management options assessment
- Draft Floodplain Risk Management Study report

An update will be provided by Council's consultant.

#### 2.4 Recent Floodplain Risk Management Plan Implementation

Council has been carrying out works to implement the currently adopted Floodplain Risk Management Plans. This include projects that have been recently completed, are underway, or are planned.

#### Collins Creek

- Ursula Road Flood Mitigation Scheme, Bulli: The concept design is nearing completion with additional modelling being undertaken to look at the benefit of drainage immediately to the west of the school. Consultation with Sydney Trains continues for obtaining permission to undertake works on their land. Detailed design development is planned to commence this calendar year.
- Bellambi Gully Flood Mitigation Scheme Detailed design development is nearing completion. Sydney Water is being consulted via our engaged Water Servicing Coordinator to obtain required approvals. Consultation with the school continues for obtaining permission to undertake works on their land.
- Debris Control Structures
  - Gordon Hutton Park Final review being undertaken.
  - Memorial Drive –Sydney Water approval is underway.
  - Russell Vale Golf Course Consultation with maintenance staff regarding access is progressing.
  - Brompton Road The Design is being reviewed to address traffic consideration.

#### 2.5 Floodplain Management Grant Applications

#### Bellambi Gully Flood Mitigation Scheme Stage 1

Council has applied for funding for construction of the Bellambi Gully Flood Mitigation Scheme, Stage 1. We have received advice that federal funding has been approved for 2/3 of the cost, to be distributed through the NSW Government's Floodplain Management Grants program.

#### Russell Vale Golf Course Debris Control Structure

Council has applied for funding for construction of the Russell Vale Golf Course Debris Control Structure. We expect to find out if we are successful later in the year (2/3 funding as part of the NSW Government's Floodplain Management Grants).
