Before I go to the library




About the library There are people who work at the library who I can talk to. The library is usually a quiet ADIU NON-AN 525-AN place where people talk quietly, relax and read books.

Sometimes it might be noisy. If it is noisy, I can talk to library staff. If I need to make a small amount of noise that's ok also.




How I become a member of the library

I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library





I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address




I will need to bring two forms of identification. This can be a driving licence, bank statement, rental receipt or household bill. One of them will need to show my name and address such as a concession card'

I can borrow a book, CD, DVD or magazine and take it home with me for four weeks




If I want to borrow a book, CD, DVD or magazine I will talk to a member of the library staff
